He looked at it and he knew with certainty that Allah Ta'ala can give life to the dead but he wanted to know how will Allah Ta'ala give life to the dead?

So, Allah Ta'ala caused him to sleep for 100 years and then caused him to wake up.

An angel asked him: "How long did you remain like this (asleep)?" He said: "I remained like this (asleep) for a day or part of a day."

He was then told that he was asleep for 100 years and that he should look at his donkey which had died. Allah Ta'ala through his power gave the donkey life again. Now he knew how Allah Ta'ala gives life to the dead. He then said: "Certainly Allah Ta'ala has power

Nabi Sallallahu Alayhi Wasallam says; “Then the angel hugged me tightly.” He let go of me and said; “Read!” Yet again I said; “I am unable to read.”

The angel hugged me for a third time and said; “Read!” Once more I said; “I am unable to read.” After that, the angel asked me to read the following aayaat:
