

## MASNŪN DUĀS AT THE TIME OF IFTĀR

اللَّهُمَّ لَكَ صُمتُ وَعَلَى رِزْقِكَ أَفْطَرْتُ

O Allah, I fasted for You and with Your provision do I break my fast. (Abu Dawūd 2358)

ذَهَبَ الظَّمَاُ وَابْتَلَّتِ العُرُوقُ وَثَبَتَ الأَجْرُ إِنْ شَاءَ اللهُ

The thirst has disappeared, the vessels have been rehydrated (i.e. the body has been refreshed) and the reward has been established, if Allah Ta'āla wills.

(Abu Dawūd 2357)

اللَّهُمَّ إِنِّي أَسْأَلُكَ بِرَحْمَتِكَ الَّتِي وَسِعَتْ كُلَّ شَيْءٍ أَنْ تَغْفِرَ لِي

O Allah, I ask You by Your mercy which envelopes everything that You forgive me. (Ibn Mājah 1753)

يَا وَاسِعَ المَغْفِرَةِ اغْفِرْ لِي

O (Allah), the Being with immense forgiveness, forgive me. (Shuabul Imān 3620)

\*أَفْطَرَ عِنْدَكُمْ الصَّائِمُونَ، وَأَكَلَ طَعَامَكُمْ الأَبْرَارُ،

وَصَلَّتْ عَلَيْكُمْ المَلَائِكَةُ

(\*This dua will be recited for the host when partaking of Ifṭār or any other meal as a guest)

May the pious partake of your food, and May the  
Angels make duā of forgiveness for you. (Abu Dawūd 3854)
