Abû Hurayrah رَضِيَ اللَّهُ عَنْهُ narrates that the Messenger of Allâh صَلَّى اللَّهُ عَلَيْهِ وَسَلَّمَ said: “There is no such thing as a contagious [disease], there is no such thing as taking an evil omen [from an owl], and there is no such thing as [bad luck] in the month of Safar.” A Bedouin asked: “O Messenger of Allâh! How is it that a camel remains on the ground like a gazelle (free from any illness), a camel which is afflicted with scabies mingles with it and causes it to be afflicted by scabies as well?” The Messenger of Allâh صَلَّى اللَّهُ عَلَيْهِ وَسَلَّمَ said: “Who is the one who caused the first animal to be afflicted by scabies?”
