


## Avoid any interaction with the opposite gender

The group arrangement of Hajj generally increases the feelings of familiarity and brotherhood between the Hujjaaj in a group.

Many times, this leads to strange males and females coming into contact with one another, which is extremely dangerous, especially in the precincts of the Haramayn Shareefayn. Couples become increasingly close, have meals together, shop together and even perform Tawaf together.



Shaytaan beautifies this by making it seem as if all this interaction is innocent and in keeping with the "friendly spirit" of Hajj. This is a great deception and extremely dangerous. Islam strictly prohibits unnecessary interaction and intermingling between unrelated males and females.



Doesn't a Muslim man's sense of honour and dignity prevent him from letting others interact with his wife? Nabi sallallaahu alayhi wa sallam said that a Dayyooth with never enter Jannah. A Dayyooth is one who is not concerned as to who visits his wife and interacts with her.
