- 1. The returning Hājī is more inclined to do good deeds and is more punctual than he was before Hajj.
- 2. He is more focused on matters of the Aakhirah (hereafter)and less attached to the world.

The Hājī should therefore strive to increase in 'Ibādah and not break any of Allah Ta'āla's commands. He should also display good character to the best of his ability.
