Avoid the unicorn and rainbow colours

Introduced in the 70's, the rainbow flag and the unicorn have evolved and become symbolic to the gay and lesbian community. LGBT activists sought a symbol to identify with. They put together colours resembling the rainbow and adopted it as their symbol.

Ordinarily, it would be permissible to use such colours, but since they have now become a salient feature of a deviate, revolting community, it is forbidden for us to use these colours.

The fatāwā of all the major Dārul Ulūms in our country have confirmed this. By displaying these colours, we unwittingly associate ourselves with them and become part of promoting these Harām and contemptible actions.
