

THE TREMENDOUS REWARDS OF FEEDING A FASTING PERSON

FEEDING SOMEONE AT IFTAAR EARNS YOU:

- THE SAME REWARD AS THEIR FAST

“Whoever feeds a fasting person at Iftaar will be granted a reward like that of the one who fasted, without diminishing his reward in the least.” (Tirmidhi 807)

- FORGIVENESS AND SAVIOUR FROM THE FIRE OF JAHANNUM

“Whosoever feeds a fasting person in (Ramadhaan) in order to break his fast, his sins are forgiven, and he will be saved from the Fire.” (Ibn Khuzaimah, 1887)

- THE HONOUR OF BEING GRANTED A DRINK FROM THE POND OF KAUTHAR

“And whoever satiates a fasting person, Allah will grant them such a drink from my Pond after which they will never feel thirsty again until they enter Paradise.” (Ibn Khuzaimah, 1887)

DON'T MISS THE OPPORTUNITY OF IMMENSE REWARD, EVEN IF YOU CAN'T MANAGE TO GIVE A FULL MEAL!

“Allah Ta'aala will grant the reward (of feeding a fasting person) to the one who feeds a fasting person, at Iftaar, a mere date, a drink of water or a sip of milk.” (Ibn Khuzaimah, 1887)

The reward of a fast, forgiveness, saviour from Jahannam and the honour of getting to drink from the pond of Kauthar for such an easy act! We should apply ourselves as best as we can to earn these incredible virtues.
