

QURBAANI ON BEHALF OF

NABI ﷺ

Hadhrat Abu Talha Radiyallaahu 'Anhu has related that Rasulullah Sallallaahu 'Alayhi Wa Sallam sacrificed two rams. When he slaughtered the first one, he said, "This is on behalf of Muhammad and his family. Thereafter, whilst sacrificing the second one, he said: "This is on behalf of every one of my Ummah who believed in me and testified (to my Nubuwwat)."

Hanash (rahmatullaahi alayh) narrates, "I saw Hadhrat 'Ali Radhiyallaahu 'anhu slaughtering two rams. I asked him, 'What is this?' He replied, 'Rasulullah Sallallaahu 'alayhi wa sallam advised me that I should slaughter an animal on his behalf. Hence, I am making Qurbaani on his behalf.'"

If means permit, it is recommended to perform a Qurbaani on behalf of Nabi Sallallaahu 'Alayhi Wa Sallam. This should be done in addition to carrying out one's own compulsory Qurbaani. This is in appreciation of the kindness of our beloved Nabi Sallallaahu 'Alayhi Wa Sallam, who carried out a Qurbaani on our behalf.
