



A'māl (actions) and Du'ās for protection

وَأُفَوِّضُ أَمْرِي إِلَى اللَّهِ إِنَّ اللَّهَ بَصِيرٌ بِالْعِبَادِ

“And I entrust my matter to Allāh. Indeed, Allāh sees (the actions of) His slaves.”

When a believing man who concealed his faith said to Fir'aun: “Will you kill a man merely because he says Allāh is my Rabb (Nourisher)?” Fir'aun intended to harm him, upon which the person responded with the above Du'ā. As a result, Allāh Ta'ālā protected him from the evil that they plotted, and the people of Fir'aun were subjected to a severe punishment.

In addition to reading the aforementioned while performing our tasks, recite at least 10 times after every Salāh.
