



A'māl (actions) and Du'ās for protection

The Muslims suffered a brief setback in the Battle of Uhud. Seeing them injured and on the back foot, the disbelievers resolved to return to Madinah Munawwarah to finish the believers off.

When the news reached the Sahābah رضي الله عنهم, they were told: "You should be terrified of the people who have gathered against you." Instead of becoming fearful, their Imān in Allāh increased, and they responded with the following Du'ā:

حَسْبُنَا اللَّهُ وَنِعْمَ الْوَكِيلُ

Translation: Allāh Ta'ālā is sufficient for us, and he is the best guardian.

In addition to reading the aforementioned while performing our tasks, recite 300 times daily.
